Data Protection statement

The Data Protection Act 1998 defines your rights as an individual in relation to the information held about you and how it may be used.

Like any membership organisation, BLRC holds information about our members, including names and addresses, other membership details, activities and history, methods of payment, and communications with the BLRC.

The most important way in which we use data is providing you with the services you have requested and the benefits available to you as a member of the BLRC. BLRC does not, as a matter of general policy; pass on information about you to third parties. In some circumstances, BLRC may provide lists of its members to other organisations in order to comply with any legal requirements.

It is absolutely essential that you trust BLRC to act responsibly and in your interests. BLRC fully accepts this responsibility and is happy to give you an undertaking that it will keep information about you up to date and accurate, and do everything it can to prevent the data from being used in any unauthorised or illegal way.

In addition to the BLRC's commitment, the Data Protection Act gives you more extensive rights in relation to the information held about you. If you feel that BLRC is using information about you in any way that which you believe may cause you (or another person) substantial damage or distress, you can write to the BLRC's Company Secretary to request that your records are no longer used in this way.
